## **Music Therapy**

Music Therapy is an established healthcare profession that uses music to address physical, emotional, cognitive, and social needs of individuals of all ages. Music Therapy can improve the quality of life for individuals who are well and also meets the needs for persons of children and adults with various disabilities or illnesses.

Music & Me is an early childhood music and movement class for mixed ages. Have fun making music together in a relaxed and playful family-style environment, where the children participate at their own level of development, in multi-sensory learning experiences.

Music making in each class will include:

Singing and vocalizing, rhythmic chants, finger plays, playing tuned or untuned percussion instruments, dancing, creative movement, music-inspired story time, active listening, making and manipulating a variety of sounds and materials, circle games, calming/bonding activities, etc.

Music activities will be designed to address: Social, emotional, physical, cognitive and musical levels of development, and adults will learn ways to continue and create music making experiences at home.

Led by a board-certified music therapist with over 20 years experience facilitating early childhood music and movement groups. Private lessons for children and adults are offered weekly in 30, 45 and 60 minute increments. All lessons are taught at First Baptist Church. Lessons are offered every semester for the instruments listed above, and others may be offered upon request.

Recital performance opportunities are offered at the end of the spring semester and in the fall semester. Students are encouraged to participate in the recitals and families and friends are invited to attend.

String Orchestra Camp is offered for four days during the first week of August to string players of all levels. Camp instruction includes small group classes and orchestra taught by FBC Academy instructors and guest instructors. Snacks and lunch are included in the tuition cost. Families, and community guests are invited to attend the closing concert offered on the last afternoon of camp. Music therapy interventions can be designed to: promote wellness, manage stress, alleviate pain, express feelings, enhance memory, improve communication, and promote physical rehabilitation. Music activities such as singing/vocalizing, movement, and instrument play are designed to be success oriented and enjoyable.

Music Therapy services at First Baptist are provided by a Board Certified Music Therapist, who has completed an undergraduate degree in Music Therapy at an accredited university. Upon registration for these services an individual assessment with the music therapist will be scheduled at a time agreed upon by the therapist and the caregiver. During this time specific questions will be asked and the client will be asked to perform specific tasks so that individual needs and goals can be established.
